He has composed and arranged hundreds of Jewish and popular songs, recorded some 20 albums and cassettes, and published 12 books of his original music. And for the benefit of his Beth Yeshurun audience, many of his

cassettes, CDs and song books will be on sale in the lobby during intermission with proceeds of the sales to be donated to the synagogue's scholarship fund.
